## **Provisional Ballot Instructions for Voter**

Voter's Copy FS 101.048(5)&(6)

**Notice:** You have voted a provisional ballot. A decision will be made by the elections canvassing board if you are an eligible voter in this jurisdiction and whether or not your vote can be counted in this election. You have the right to provide written evidence supporting your eligibility to vote to the Supervisor of Elections office, no later than 5 p.m. of the second day following the election.

Attention: If you have voted this ballot because we could not verify your Florida driver's license number, Florida state identification card number of the last four digits of your social security number, bring your card in person or provide a copy via mail, fax or email to the Supervisor of Elections by the deadline listed above. If you voted this ballot solely because you did not have proper photo and signature identification, you do not have to provide any further evidence. Your ballot will be counted if your signature on the provisional ballot envelope certificate matches the signature on your registration record and if you voted in the proper precinct.

You have the right to find out if your ballot was counted, and if not, the reason why. You may check the status of your provisional ballot either by phone or online using the Okeechobee County Supervisor of Elections website.
